Komen Tissue Bank Medical Partner Overview

If you are a breast cancer researcher interested in collaborating with the KTB to host a collection event in your city, the following information may be helpful:

- The KTB plans one out-of-town event per year.
 - This event is planned a year or more in advance, and is a collaborative partnership between the Komen Tissue Bank / Indiana University and the medical partner.
 - We need to collaborate with a medical partner, which is usually an academic medical center, although other options are possible.
 - During the planning period, the KTB will host medical partner staff members at a collection event in Indianapolis to allow all to see and experience a tissue collection. Our events are unique and usually challenging to describe or envision unless witnessed in person.
- We are looking for partners <u>in cities with noticeable ethnic and racial diversity</u>, who are interested in hosting this one-time event.
- A KTB tissue collection event is usually overseen by the Indiana University IRB in partnership with the medical partner's IRB.
- There will be an opportunity for the medical partner to obtain/retain some of the tissue samples collected at the event.
- These events can be a time-intensive process for a short term but feedback from past participants is overwhelmingly positive. Previous medical partners have enjoyed and benefited from the experience; should you wish to speak with prior partners, we are happy to connect you to facilitate a conversation.
- There will also be involvement from community partners, usually including your local Komen affiliate and other organizations that focus on and work with minority communities.
